Course Numbers, Prefixes and Titles:

Certification of UC and CSU Transferable Courses:

Students enrolled in the summer 2019 term will need to manually designate which courses are transferable on their California State University and University of California applications.

Transcripts of Record

- Coursework completed between August 22, 2006 and June 7, 2019 (fall 2006 through spring 2019) is under the El Camino College catalog requirements. Order El Camino College transcripts online: www.elcamino.edu/admissions/transcripts.
- As of June 8, 2019 (beginning with the summer 2019 term), coursework completed at Compton College is under the Compton College catalog requirements.

A transcript of all college work completed at Compton College may be obtained by submitting a request in person at the Admissions and Records Office. Students may obtain an unofficial copy of their transcript for their own personal reference via *MyCompton* at www.compton.edu.

The first two official transcripts are free. For subsequent copies, a fee of \$6 is charged for each regular transcript; a \$9 fee is charged for each express request (available for next-day pick up at the Admissions and Records Office).

Note: Failure by a student to pay fees and fines required by Compton College may result in the withholding of grades, transcripts, diplomas or registration privileges, or any combination thereof (California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 59410).
