### 1. Follow-up Items:

Dr. Curry reported that the Student Release form had been approved by the Chancellor's office. He asked for a timeline, and Richette Bell stated that the timeline had been completed. Dr. Curry reported that the resolution to terminate the partnership with El Camino College District would be presented to the Compton Community College District Board of Trustees for approval at the October 16, 2018, board meeting.

### 2. Transition Committee Updates:

#### A. Admissions & Records:

Richette Bell – Reported on CCCApply; she and Andrei Yermakov met with the implementation team, and the system should be ready to receive applications by November 1, 2018. Dr. Lieble and his team have requested samples to test. Ms. Bell stated that they are moving forward with the implementation of CCCApply, and she has also met with Andrei Yermakov and a potential vendor for support of processes in the Admissions and Records office.

Heather Parnock mentioned “Regroup” vendor that sends email notices to students. She discussed how students are to be notified and will send an email. Timeline: the first email to go out on September 12, 2018; the second email to be sent out in October. There will be a series of four emails or text messages, with the last being sent on June 30, 2019. She will send further information to be added to the timeline. Heather Parnock reported the 3-year report has been mailed to the community and emailed to the Compton College employees.

Dr. Curry said he would email information to faculty on Thursday morning regarding the student records release form.

#### B. Academic Affairs:

Dr. Atkinson-Alston. Reported that the Academic Senate has done the first reading of the curriculum, and it will be presented to the Board of Trustees at the September 11, 2018, Board meeting for approval.

C. Student Services:

Elizabeth Martinez – No updates.

D. Business Services:

Steve Haigler reported that Business Services is continuing with the PeopleSoft implementation. Has received information from El Camino College regarding processes for transitioning Compton College and Compton Community College District financial records.

E. Communications:

Heather Parnock will send an email regarding the student release forms.

F. Financial Aid:

Keith Cobb reported that they are waiting on the curriculum to be approved by the Chancellors Office for Compton College. He also advised Dr. Curry that he is required to take 20 hours of online training, plus a face-to-face session.

G. ITS:

Andrei Yermakov reported on CCCApply – he is testing importing records; sign-on, and transcript credentials.

H. Police Services:

Lt. Ramund Box reported that everything is on schedule, no updates.

I. Nursing:

Dr. Morris reported that the Nursing curriculum had been approved by El Camino College. Next week it will be submitted to the BRN. The cost to submit is \$1,000 for the RN and \$5,000 for the BRN to review the LVM. She is updating her web pages with all new information. The First information session for the Nursing department will be held on September 6, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. They are still looking for a director. She also reviewed “NCLEX-RN Pass Rate First-Time Candidates for El Camino College Compton Center nursing students, 2013-2014 through 2017-2018.
