- 2. Follow-Up Items from March 3, 2020 meeting**
 - A. National Student Clearinghouse: Admissions and Records waiting on approval from the National Clearinghouse on the latest data submissions. Working with Ellucian to resolve the matter, should know soon.
 - B. ECC Data Sharing Agreement: Lauren Sosenko is working with El Camino College to operationalize the Data Sharing Agreement. El Camino College Board of Trustees has not approved the addendum to the agreement.
- 3. Compton CCD 2016-2021 Partnership Plan** – Dr. Curry reviewed the updated Compton CCD 2016-2021 Partnership Plan.
- 4. Areas of Focus**
 - A. Admissions and Records: Richette Bell provide an update on the Compton College Transcript. Compton College is moving forward with credentials online transcripts and will begin testing next week. Admissions and Record is setting up the EW code in Banner. Argos Reports need to run all students who drop since March 9, 2020. The process will be completed within one week. Compton College is looking into the Pass/No Pass Option, and in the coming weeks a final decisions will be made. Admissions and Records staff has scheduled BDM training for staff.

- B. Academic Affairs: Dr. Curry will oversee Academic Affairs until the Vice President of Academic Affairs has been hired.
- C. Student Services: Dr. Nelly Alvarado provided an update on Comevo and are hopefully the online orientation will be completed in the coming weeks.
- D. Financial Aid: Conversation about Banner support and how long will the support be provided. Dr. Curry will follow-up with Elusion.
- E. Business Services: Dr. Curry introduced Stephen Kibui as the new Vice President of Administrative Services.
- F. Communications: Heather Parnock is working on follow-up items from the previous meetings and updating the communication guide.
- G. Information Technology: Andrei Yermakov provide an update on form fusion solution for Banner. Lauren Sosenko and Barbara Perez will follow-up regarding the priorities for Argos Report development.
- H. Police Services: Chief Box reported secured vendors or the Police Department and is working on completing the hiring of police officers and they are in the process a hiring a dispatcher.
