El Camino College Compton Center is proud to announce that six athletes will sign letters of intent, in accordance with national rules for Division 1, on Wednesday, February 4 at noon, in the lobby of the campus gymnasium. Division 1 is the top level of intercollegiate athletics in the country.

The Compton Center football players and their respective colleges or universities are Reggie Dunn, a wide receiver, Oregon State; Jewell Hardy, a wide receiver, University of Colorado; Maxwell Lacy, a cornerback, University of Utah; Branden Warner, a defensive tackle, University of California, Los Angeles; Christian Browne-Frazier, an offensive tackle, Utah State; and Markish Jones, a wide receiver, who will be choosing to sign a letter of intent for University of California, Berkley; Oregon, Louisville or Arizona State.

All of the athletes have achieved the academic requirements for each institution that recruited them and offered a letter of intent. They will be graduates of Compton Center by the end of the spring semester. Each student athlete will receive a full scholarship to the four-year college or university they will be attending.

Albert "Lefty" Olguin, Director of Athletics, says: "I am very proud of the character of the young men on and off the field and of their achievements in the classroom. Our motto at Compton Center is: Recruit, Educate, Matriculate and Graduate. The focus is not on wins and losses, but on the future of our athletes."
