## **EL CAMINO COLLEGE COMPTON CENTER HOSTS “BABY CITY” OPEN HOUSE**

El Camino College Compton Center’s Foster & Kinship Care Education Program will present “Baby City” on Saturday, October 25, 2008. Baby City is a program that was developed for pregnant teens and foster youth who are parents and need education and training to positively parent their children. It was created through the Pregnancy and Parenting Teen sub-committee of the Inter-Agency Committee on Child Abuse and Neglect of Los Angeles, to address this issue.

The event, being held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the Foster & Kinship Care building on campus, will focus on the specific needs of foster and former foster youth as they begin parenting. Several county agencies and departments, including First 5 LA and the Los Angeles Department of Children and Family Services, will provide information and access to resources for participants. The day-long program is free, and participants will have a complimentary breakfast and lunch.
