El Camino College Compton Center Financial Aid Office Notes Approaching Cal Grant Deadline

El Camino College Compton Center's financial aid office offers a reminder that the deadline for applying for a Cal Grant is Monday, March 2, 2009. A Cal Grant is one of the best ways to get cash for college—it is a cash award you don't have to pay back! Depending on the type of Cal Grant you receive, the money can be used for tuition, books or supplies.

If you are a graduating senior or recent high school graduate, meet academic, financial and eligibility requirements and submit two forms by March 2, you are guaranteed a Cal Grant. You need to submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and a Cal Grant GPA Verification Form. You can follow the step-by-step process online at CalGrants.org.
