Register Now for El Camino College Compton Center Fall Semester

New and returning students may now register for El Camino College Compton Center's fall semester, and financial aid is available to qualifying students.

Register online by going to www.compton.edu and clicking on *MyECC*, or by telephone at 310-516-9339. Computers are available for student use in the Welcome Center, Financial Aid Lab, Admissions and Records Office, VT 209 and Library. Students must have a registration appointment prior to going online or calling to register. Go to www.compton.edu and click on *MyECC – Registration Appointment Time* or call 310-516-9339 to confirm individual registration dates and times.

Registration and counseling will be available in the Student Lounge beginning Monday, August 11 through Friday, September 11; and on two Saturdays -- August 29 and September 5. Registration hours are Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., and Saturday from 8:00a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Students are encouraged to apply for financial aid to get cash for college, even if they think they may not be eligible. Many people are unaware that they meet the requirements to receive financial aid. There is available money set aside by state and federal governments to help people pay for a college education and it comes in many forms such as grants and scholarships—some of which are free and do not have to be paid back. The first step in gaining access to financial aid is to fill out the free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>.
