The workshop will be taught by veteran teacher Richard Nicholson who has more than 40 years of experience and will answer questions about teaching Career and Technical Education subjects in a variety of educational settings.

People with at least five years experience in a particular trade may earn a Designated Subjects Credential from the State of California, which qualifies credentialed individuals to teach in a Regional Occupational Center or Program, as well as act as substitute teachers for some school districts.
