Compton Community College District Conducts Annual Organizational Meeting

Board of Trustee Members Take Oath of Office, Elect Officers

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) held a swearing-in ceremony for two Board of Trustee members on December 15. The two incumbent trustees, Leslie Irving and Sonia Lopez were appointed in lieu of an election, in an uncontested race.

As part of its annual organizational meeting, the Board of Trustees also elected officers. Irving was elected president for the second consecutive year, Andres Ramos was elected vice president; and LoWanda Green will serve as clerk.

In addition, Lopez will serve as the district representative to the Los Angeles County School Trustees Association, and as a member of the Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization. Deborah LeBlanc will review nominations for membership on the California Community College Trustees Board and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees.

Compton Community College District Board of Trustees members are responsible for attending all Board meetings and key El Camino College Compton Center events, as well as participating in trustee education programs. The elected Board of Trustees have the authority to make motions, deliberate and provide an advisory vote, as well as participate in “closed session” meetings. The state-appointed Special Trustee continues to provide oversight and guidance, as well as maintain the authority provided in AB 318.
