Compton Community College District Temporarily Closes Track and Football/Soccer Field for Upgrades

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) has temporarily closed the Football/Soccer Stadium for renovations to the football field and upgrades to the track. The track and fields are scheduled to reopen for public use on Sunday, September 6, 2015. The stadium bleachers and restrooms will remain open during construction. The track and field are located at 1111 E. Artesia Boulevard, Compton, CA 90221.

This is a \$2.5 million dollar project support by Measure CC bond funds. The closure is occurring in order to make needed improvements and upgrades so the football/soccer field will be ready for the upcoming Tartar season. The work being done includes new artificial turf, goal posts and a refurbished track. It is important that these upgrades be completed without interference for proper field maintenance, and more importantly, for the safety of both Tartar athletes and community members who use this resource.

While the upgrades are taking place, an alternative location for walking and running is the perimeter of the CCCD property. Signs have been posted at all entrances to the track and football/soccer field notifying the public of the temporary closure.

We apologize for any inconvenience to members of the community who regularly use the track and field, and ask for your patience while these essential upgrades are being completed. After construction has been completed the hours of operation of the track for members of the community will be 4:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
