Applications Available Now for Summer and Fall 2017 at El Camino College Compton Center

Early Registration Available to All New Students

Applying early to El Camino College Compton Center was a good move for Oscar Gonzalez-Ortega. He enrolled in ECC Compton Center during his senior year at Rancho Dominguez Preparatory School just prior to graduating in spring 2015. By completing his application and [Four Steps to Enrollment](#) early, he received priority registration status and was able to get the classes he needed.

“Enrollment went very smooth for me,” said Gonzalez-Ortega. “I attended the ECC Compton Center outreach sessions at my high school, which helped me with the steps to enroll. A Compton Center student services advisor helped me determine which classes would be best for my schedule overall.”

Gonzalez-Ortega said he visited the ECC Compton Center campus regularly during his application and registration process. “My advice to other students going through the enrollment process is don’t be afraid to ask questions, because the staff at Compton Center are a great help,” he said.

Applications for summer and fall 2017 are now being accepted at El Camino College Compton Center. All new students can qualify for earlier registration if they complete the four steps to enroll by April 30, 2017:

APPLY – New students must complete an application.

PREPARE – All new students must participate in an orientation session.

TEST – Assessment testing must be completed prior to registering for classes.

PLAN – Students must meet with a counselor prior to registration to develop an education plan.

Before registering, prospective students can check out the ECC Compton Center online electronic brochure. This customizable e-brochure can be downloaded, saved, or printed by prospective students, their parents, and community members. The e-brochure features

Priority Registration is available to students living within the Compton Community College District and students who graduate from high schools within the district. The Compton Community College District includes: Compton, Lynwood, Paramount and Willowbrook, as well as portions of Athens, Bellflower, Carson, Downey, Dominguez, Lakewood, North Long Beach and Southgate. In-district students must complete all four steps to enroll at ECC Compton Center before April 30, 2017 to be eligible for priority registration.

Current high school seniors interested in attending ECC Compton Center for summer or fall 2017 are encouraged to apply and complete all four of the required [Steps to Enrollment](#) as early as possible, even if they haven't made their final decision about higher education.

ECC Compton Center's summer 2017 sessions begin June 19; fall 2017 begins August 26. Apply online, 24 hours per day via the ECC Compton Center website www.compton.edu.
