## **Register NOW for Spring 2019 at Compton College** *Apply Online Today and Visit the Welcome Center for Registration Assistance*

Compton College student Anthony Onwuegbuzia just needs to take two more classes this spring to earn his Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T). “I registered for sociology and physical geography to satisfy my AA-T requirements,” said Onwuegbuzia, a sociology major. “Then I will be all ready to transfer to a UC campus next fall.” The AA-T helps expedite the transfer process for students who are pursuing the same major for a bachelor's degree, in which they also earned their associate degree. He is currently a participant in UCLA's Community College to PhD Scholars program and hopes to have a future career as a sociology professor.

The spring semester begins Feb. 9, 2019. Online registration for the spring semester at Compton College is currently underway for all students, where plenty of classes and a variety of student support programs are available to help students meet their academic and career goals. Online registration for spring 2019 continues through Feb. 8 and the last day to add classes is Feb. 22. Classes are available in high-demand subjects such as English, math, science, history, communications, child development, Spanish, political science, and sociology, to name a few.

### **In-Person Registration Assistance**

In-person registration assistance will be available beginning Jan. 28 through Feb. 22, and on one Saturday – Feb. 9. Students may apply and register for the spring 2019 semester in a convenient location where computers will be available, as well as counselors and financial aid representatives. The Welcome Center, Assessment Center, Admissions, Counseling, Financial Aid, and Student Life offices will all be open the following hours to assist students with registration for the spring semester:

**Fee Payment Options and Deadlines**

The last day to pay all student fees in-person or be dropped from ALL classes is Feb. 1, and the last day to pay online is Feb. 3. We offer three easy ways to pay registration fees:

Waitlisted students admitted to the class must pay those class fees by the same deadlines listed above, or they will be dropped from all classes at both Compton College and El Camino College.
