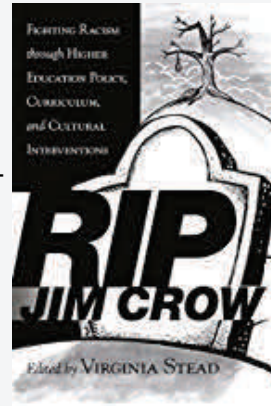


**RIP Jim Crow : Fighting Racism through Higher Education Policy, Curriculum, and Cultural Interventions**

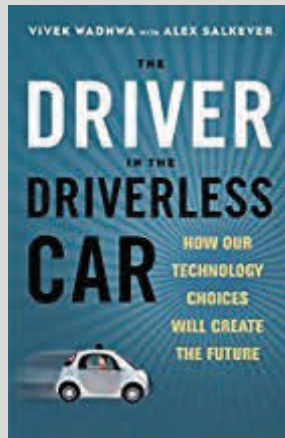
