

## **Benefits of Utilizing Supplemental Instruction**

The Supplemental Instruction program at El Camino College Compton Center functions as a part of the Student Success Center. Data reports are created at the end of each semester; this is our main evaluation tool. In the past two semesters Fall 2015 and Spring 2015 the common trend is that students who attended 9 + (or more) SI sessions in the semester had a higher success and retention rate than those who either did not attend an SI session or attended fewer than 9 sessions. The data listed below is a representation of the SI data for a couple of Math and English courses. The attached data set will provide detailed information.

### **Math 23 Fall 2015**
