

Library

The Library, located on the first floor, is open to the public; however, only currently enrolled ECC Compton Center students may check out materials or reserve books. Also available: library research instruction, library reference services, and group study rooms.

Student Success Center

The Student Success Center is located on the second floor, where students have access to four drop-in tutorial centers, including general tutoring, a Writing Center, Math & Science Center, and Reading Success Center. The Student Success Center also offers a Supplemental Instruction (SI) program, Directed Learning Activities (DLA), academic skills workshops, and peer-led tutoring.

Math & Science Center

The Math & Science Center provides free group tutoring on a drop-in basis by trained peer tutors and adjunct faculty tutors. The Math & Science Center sponsors programs to further assist math students. The Math Workshop Series is a series of one-hour workshops presented by tutors covering topics from basic math to college algebra.

Reading Success Center

Individual assistance is available on a drop-in basis for students who need to learn reading strategies to help them succeed in class. Reading Success Center tutors are available on a drop-in basis, no appointment necessary.

Writing Center

The Writing Center provides free tutoring on a drop-in basis. Tutors assist students in deciphering writing tasks, organizing writing assignments, and developing content and critical thinking. While the tutors do not provide copy editing services, the tutors do assist students in identifying and correcting specific grammatical errors. In addition, the center provides a Workshop Series presented by a faculty tutor. This series provides focused instruction on particular skills and writing tasks, from fragment identification to scholarship essays.

Academic Tutoring

Tutoring is available to all ECC Compton Center students. The tutorial program is certified through the highly recognized College Reading and Learning Association. Tutoring is available in various subjects such as anatomy, math, nursing, English, chemistry, Spanish, physiology, English as a Second Language (ESL), and many others. All tutoring sessions are available on a drop-in basis, no appointment necessary.

Supplemental Instruction

Supplemental Instruction (SI) is a series of weekly review sessions for courses that have been proven to be historically difficult for many students. SI is available to all students who want to improve understanding of course material. Attendance at SI sessions is voluntary. Students are given the opportunity to compare notes; discuss important concepts; study for tests; and develop strategies for studying and learning.

Multi-Disciplinary Computer Lab

A new Multidisciplinary Computer Lab features 100 new computers with a variety of academic software for students to utilize for computer-aided learning, word processing and research.
