Steps to Enrollment for High Achieving K-10 Students

K-10 students will need the approval of the Vice President of Academic Affairs for admission to a class. K-10 students should be **high achieving with no grades less than a “B.”** The following documents are needed for consideration:

1. **A signed letter from the principal on “school letterhead,”** clearly stating how the student has the ability to benefit from enrolling in the course at El Camino College.
2. **A signed letter from the parent** giving permission for the student to enroll in a class at El Camino College (Compton Center).
3. **A copy of the student’s school transcript(s)** (unofficial is okay)
4. **Proof Steps to Enrollment were completed (See Attached)**
 - Online Admissions Application available at www.compton.edu
 - Mandatory New Student Orientation
 - Take both the English and Math assessment tests
5. **A signed K-12 Concurrent Enrollment Application with classes** for consideration.

Submit all documents, letters, transcripts, and test scores to the Admissions Office (Administration Building A) for review. The Vice President of Academic Affairs makes the final approval. You will receive an email to your MyECC email account and your personal email stating if your application has been processed.

Applying for Concurrent Enrollment does not guarantee a seat in a class. Registration priority is first given to new students, followed by continuing students and returning students, and finally to K-12 Concurrent Enrollment students.
