

Spring 2024 Federal Direct Student Loan Workshops

Federal Direct Student Loans are provided by the Department of Education to help provide low-interest loans for students and parents to help pay for educational costs. Compton College students can apply for three types of Federal Direct Student Loans: 1) Subsidized, 2) Unsubsidized, and 3) Parent Plus.

The Federal Direct Student Loan workshop educates Compton College students about the Federal Direct Student Loan programs and how to manage these loans. To be eligible for a Federal Direct Student Loan, students must be eligible to submit a FAFSA application, meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements, be enrolled in at least 6 units.

Student who complete the necessary paperwork and meet all requirements will be invited to attend one of our Federal Direct Student Loan workshops.
