We do that by providing comprehensive transfer preparation for historically marginalized, underrepresented, and underserved community college students. Our programming includes academic planning, sustained transfer advising, and opportunities to participate in academic enrichment programs. In collaboration with key partners, we provide individualized, student-centered support throughout the transfer application process and enrollment at the university.

A TAP participant is a student who meets at least two of the following criteria:

- Low-income student
- First-generation college student (meaning that neither parents/guardians have completed a four-year college degree)
- Historically underrepresented in higher education

Enrolled at one of the <u>69 community</u> <u>colleges</u> designated as a low-sending school by the UC Office of the President.
