Compton Community College District Trustees Elected Officers of the African American California Community College Trustees Caucus

Two members of the Compton Community College District Board of Trustees were elected to serve as officers of the African American California Community College Trustees Caucus (AACCCT), a caucus of the Community College League of California (CCLC), on April 30. Deborah Sims LeBlanc (Area 4) was elected president, and John P. Hamilton (Area 2) will serve as vice president.

The elections were held at an official meeting of the AACCCT in Long Beach, Calif., during the annual conference of the Community College League of California. In addition to electing officers, members of the AACCCT adopted by-laws, discussed best practices for trustees in the accreditation process, and approved the proposed 2010-2011 work plan.

The mission of the AACCCT is to strengthen the position of African Americans within California's community college system; to increase the number of African Americans elected, selected and/or appointed to executive positions; and to groom and prepare our next generation, aspiring administrators for future senior management posts and elected positions in higher education.
