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3B. What were the most important findings from the data?

The most important finding was that students are generally satisfied with library services; however, students expressed concerns regarding the age of the collection and building through lower ratings.



3C. What changes can be made to address these implications (e.g. changes to the program, Curriculum, teaching method, etc.)?

A weeding to upgrade the collection is in progress, and new books (print and e-books) will be integrated into the existing collection. Additional databases should be added to our current offerings. Teaching methods should include more hands-on experience with database and online catalog searching for students, as well as for interested faculty and staff.

After the move to the new LRC building, the facilities rating should improve.
