Several programs were removed from the Licensure Examination Pass Rate table because Compton College no longer offers these programs under its curriculum as an independent institution. Although these programs have historically had students completing them, we were unable to disaggregate the numbers of Compton College students from El Camino College students. The table included in this year's report reflects only the available disaggregated student data specific to Compton College.

Job placement rates presented according to data obtained from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Core Indicator Reports for Career Technical Education (Perkins IV). Cells listed with "N/A" indicate placement data is available but refers to fewer than 10 students for the designated year.
