AGENDA:

- Welcome new members.
Mayela Rodriguez and Jose Garcia were welcomed as new members.
- Faculty Teaching and Learning Action Plan (update)
There was discussion about how the Faculty Teaching and Learning Action Plan is still currently under review. Corina discussed how in the Action Plan, she requested \$30,000 for workshops. As the review process won't be complete until October, the proposed workshops would be pushed be held during the Spring 2024 and Fall 2024 semesters.
- Revisiting Goals for the academic year:
 1. Recruitment update (update).
 - Clarification of PD liaisons' duties as ex-officio members of the FDC committee (update).
There was discussion as to the duties of PD liaisons (PLEC) and the FDC. PLEC requires 2 reps per division and is a space for all groups to share updates. There was concusses to have FDC faculty participate in PLECT. Corina volunteered to go to PLEC.

There was also conversation about how to connect and bring together all the different PD events and workshops going on in different divisions so that work isn't being duplicated.

There was also discussion about reaching out to BIS to recruit a faculty member for FDC.
 2. PD handbook policies (update).
There was discussion as to if an FDC handbook exists that is separate than PD Handbook. After reviewing the FDC portion of the PD handbook, it was determined that FDC does not need to develop its own handbook. Instead it was determined that there would be revisions made to the FDC portion of the PD Handbook. These revisions would include:
 - Allowing only 2 faculty absences per semester
 - Defining position terms
 - Staggering position terms so there would be complete turnover

The possibility of holding FDC meetings over Zoom was also discussed and Corina will follow up with Minodora about this concern.
