Heather Parnock reviewed the Entry to Campus Protocol Phase-Out Time (included in today's agenda) which she updated on Thursday. It contains all of the feedback collected so far. The Health, Safety, and Parking Committee will review and edit this document at their meeting on March 16, 2022.

C. **2022-2023 Compton College Outreach and Recruitment**

Vice President Nicole Jones reviewed her 2022-2023 Compton College Outreach and Recruitment Plan, focusing on connection and entry, specifically from our Tartar Completion by Design framework. We're focused heavily on recruiting prospective students, and we have been convening a cross-functional committee to discuss where we should focus our outreach and our energies for the 2022-2023 year. We are tying it to the 2024 Enrollment Management Plan. Some of the outreach and recruitment strategies conversations are also starting to overlay with our outreach and enrollment management committee.

Dr. Keith Curry commented that whatever activities are tied to marketing, recruitment, mailers, robocalls, etc. Who is being called, what mailers are going out? Where is the target data coming from for those individuals? It needs to be tight, and we need to start sending information out in April and early May so we may know exactly what we are doing for the whole year.

Discussion regarding Faculty Club Advisors. Christopher Perez shared that he has been trying to increase the number of faculty advisors. Dr. Curry asked if we have a plan for this and have he

had a conversation at the Compton College Academic Senate meeting.

3. Compton College Commencement Ceremony – June 10, 2022

Heather Parnock announced that the Commencement Ceremony would be held on June 10, 2022, at the Dignity Health Sports Center in the Tennis Stadium on California State University, Dominguez Hills.

The conversation regarding stoles was discussed at the meeting and the Associated Student Government. Dr. Curry mentioned that he needs to review this and the past practice and will issue a policy statement on the matter.
