



## 2026-2028 President/CEO Priorities



1. Monitor and advance implementation of [Compton College 2035](#), the [2026-2028 Compton College Goals](#), and the [Institutional Set Goals - Compton 2035](#); use disaggregated evidence and the [Institutional Set Goals Dashboard](#) to report progress and guide action.  
*Alignment: College Goals 1-7.*
2. Lead college-wide action to identify and remove barriers and increase transfer-level English and mathematics throughput for first-time students, with particular attention to equity gaps, course success, persistence, and withdrawals.  
*Alignment: College Goal 1; Compton College 2035: Strategic Enrollment Management Objective 4, Strategies 4.A and 4.C.*
3. Advance recruitment, retention, academic program course offering, and resource-allocation strategies that increase enrollment, persistence, and timely completion while building campus-wide understanding and use of Student-Centered Funding Formula metrics.  
*Alignment: College Goal 7; Compton College 2035: Strategic Enrollment Management Objective 4, Strategies 4.A and 4.B.*
4. Evaluate and modernize technology resources, infrastructure, software, accessibility, cybersecurity, data governance, and business continuity to close digital equity gaps, improve student experience, and strengthen institutional efficiency.

5. Implement strategies that remove barriers to student success and completion, including the responsible use of artificial intelligence to improve services and efficiency; expanded OER, Zero-Textbook-Cost pathways, and low- and no-cost textbook options to reduce costs; and Credit for Prior Learning to accelerate progress toward certificates, degrees, transfer, and employment.

6. Complete and open the Student Housing Complex, support the successful move-in of the first resident cohort, integrate housing within the campus operations, and evaluate the first-year residential experience to improve student well-being, persistence, and completion.

7. Strengthen institutional capacity and leadership continuity by completing the Collaborative Governance Handbook revision, updating the Succession Plan, and promoting professional development responsive to emerging technologies, equity-minded practice, and student success.

8. Support the Foundation for the Compton Community College District and secure grants, philanthropy, partnerships, and other external resources that advance the 2026-2028 College Goals and institutional sustainability.

9. Continue the implementation of the Academic Affairs reorganizational plan and monitor recommendations from the California Competes project to strengthen alignment among workforce development, adult education, noncredit-to-credit pathways, and regional education and employment needs.

10. Maintain oversight of active facilities projects, including closeout and operational readiness, while monitoring state and District budgets, implementing applicable FCMAT recommendations, and ensuring fiscal integrity and transparent resource stewardship.
