President/CEO Message - June 25, 2026

Campus Community,

Happy first week of the summer 2026 sessions. It has been great to see students on campus. This week, we are also awaiting finalization of the California State Budget for 2026-2027. Once the state budget is released, we will begin preparing the Compton Community College District 2026-2027 Final Budget Assumptions and the Compton CCD 2026-2027 Final Budget.

Next week, students are invited to attend the “Summertime Bash” on **Tuesday, June 30, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.** in Vocational Technology Building 125. The event will allow students to explore majors, meet their Guided Pathway Success Team, connect with peers in their Guided Pathway Division, and enjoy games and free food.

This week’s message includes summer and fall enrollment updates, information about the Campus Police Student Advisory Committee, and a reminder about the Independence Day holiday closure.

June 25, 2026, Compton College Summer Enrollment Update

- **Summer 2026:** 616 FTES, and 5,143 (77%) of the available seats are currently filled.
- **Fall 2026:** 822 FTES, and 5,521 (31%) of the available seats are currently filled.

President/CEO Closing the Loop

As a follow-up to the [President/CEO Message – April 24, 2026](#), I am pleased to share that the Campus Police Student Advisory Committee has been approved. This committee will provide students with a structured opportunity to share feedback, ask questions, and work collaboratively with the Compton Community College District Police Department on matters related to campus safety.

The committee is intended to strengthen communication, transparency, and collaboration between students and Campus Police, while supporting shared problem-solving around student concerns and the campus environment.

The Campus Police Student Advisory Committee will include six students:

- Two students selected by the Associated Student Government;
- Two students who are members of chartered clubs, selected by the Director of Student Development and Housing, and
- Two student-athletes selected by the Dean of Athletics and Student Support Services.

The committee will meet no more than three times per academic year.

Final Thoughts

As mentioned in the [President/CEO Message – June 12, 2026](#), the draft [Collaborative Governance Handbook](#) continues to move through the campus review process. Recent conversations have focused on giving each constituent group sufficient time to review the draft, share feedback, and understand how their input will be considered before the handbook is finalized. Additional updates will be provided as the [Academic Senate](#), [Consultative Council](#), and other campus groups continue their review.

Reminder: Independence Day falls on a Saturday this year. In observance of the holiday, the District will be closed on **Thursday, July 2, 2026**. With our 4/10 summer work schedule, the District will also be closed on **Friday, July 3, 2026**, making it an extended holiday weekend. There will not be a President/CEO Message next week. Weekly messages will resume the following week after the holiday.
