Federal Work Study (FWS)

The Federal Work-Study program is a federally funded program that provides on-campus employment opportunity to undergraduate students to gain workplace experience. Your total Work Study award depends on when you apply, your level of need, and the funding level of your school. To be eligible, you must qualify for a Pell Grant, be enrolled in at least 6 units, have a completed FAFSA application, and be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Learning Aligned Employment Program (LAEP)

The Learning Aligned Employment Program offer eligible students at Compton College the opportunity to earn money to help defer their educational cost while gaining education-aligned, career-related employment. Your total LAEP award depends on when you apply, your level of need, and the funding level of your school. To be eligible, you must demonstrate financial need, be enrolled in at least 6 units, have a completed FAFSA or CADAA application, be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress, be a California Resident, and be eligible to work in the US.
