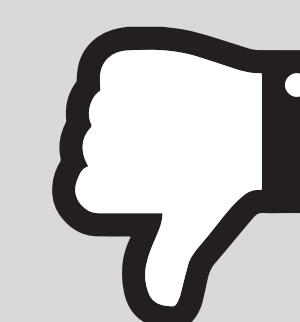

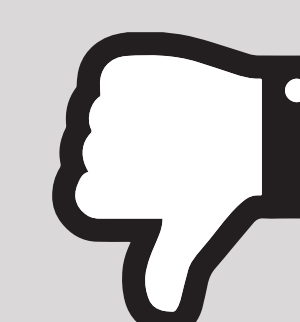
Students on financial aid warning are provided one semester to improve their academic performance before being disqualified. Also, students with an approved appeal must meet specific conditions to maintain their eligibility.
