Trespass Warning



Compton College Campus Police advises students and employees to be on the lookout for the person pictured above.

Eduardo Flores, who is not a Compton College student, was arrested by Compton College Campus Police at approximately 5:45 p.m. on December 10, 2019 near the Little Theater for trespassing on Compton Community College District property.

Flores had been escorted off campus earlier in the day for harassing a Compton College student. Campus Police responded to a call around 5:20 p.m. yesterday regarding Flores harassing the same Compton College student. A chase ensued and Flores was detained by Campus Police and subsequently arrested for trespassing and transported to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Century Regional Detention Facility for booking. As of 11 a.m. today, Flores has made bail.

Flores is described as a 22-year-old Hispanic male, 5 feet, 5 inches tall, weighing 170 pounds.
