Thank you for your recent notification to the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) regarding the status of Compton College's Midterm Report. We look forward to receiving the report.

Per ACCJC policies and resources, ACCJC accredited institutions are required to submit a Midterm Report in the fourth year of the accreditation cycle. The purpose of the report is for the institution to provide information to the Commission on the actions taken in response to the improvement recommendations identified in the College's Peer Review Team Report, as well as updates on the College's self-identified improvement plans per the Institutional Self-Evaluation Report and the Quality Focus Projects outlined in the Quality Focus Essay. The Commission does not prescribe the actions the institution must take in pursuit of continuous quality improvement.

Institutions have the responsibility to design and conduct their own internal accreditation processes. It is expected that the institution will involve the appropriate constituency groups in the preparation of the report and it is up to each institution to determine those groups. For clarification, the signatures provided by the institution on the certification page do not stipulate approval of the report, only that the appropriate groups were included and had the ability to provide feedback. Therefore, the Commission will review the report as submitted.
