Compton College District Police to Host Community Meeting on Military Equipment Inventory Pursuant to AB 481

Community invited to learn about and provide input on District police military equipment

The Compton College District Police Department will hold a community engagement meeting on **Thursday, May 14 from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.** to provide information about the District's police military equipment inventory and to allow members of the public to ask questions and provide input. The meeting will take place in the Allied Health Building (AHB), Room 119, located at 1111 E. Artesia Boulevard, Compton, CA 90221.

[Assembly Bill 481 \(2021\)](#) requires California law enforcement agencies to obtain governing board approval for the acquisition and use of certain equipment defined in statute as "military equipment" and to provide public transparency regarding such equipment. In accordance with AB 481 and direction from the Compton Community College District Board of Trustees, the District is taking steps to come into full compliance with the law, including hosting a public community meeting regarding the District Police Department's military equipment inventory.
