1	Would it be possible to get a Building list and corresponding square footage information for all facilities that will be included in the ADA Assessment?	All buildings on campus shall be included in the ADA Assessment. See Attachment 1 to RFP CCC-072 document for campus map. Based on fusion, the current square footage of the 88 acre campus facilities is 466,119 GSF.
2	The current Transition Plan and Self Evaluation is 12 years old. Within those 12 years, there can be changes of use, repairs made to spaces that are not ADA compliant. Our experience with trying to update a Transition Plan that old would take considerably more time, pose risk for inaccuracy, and make a less coherent report as well as add to the cost of the report. Would Compton Community College be willing to accept a brand new report identifying all the current barriers and a new Transition Plan to ensure current compliance?	Yes, the District is willing to accept a brand new report identifying all the current barriers and a new Transition Plan to ensure current compliance.
