**BP 4240 Academic Renewal**

The President/Chief Executive Officer shall, in consultation with the appropriate groups, develop procedures that provide for academic renewal. It is the policy of Compton Community College District to allow previously recorded substandard coursework to be disregarded in the computation of a student's grade point average if it is not reflective of a student's more recently demonstrated ability, and if repetition is not appropriate to the current objectives of the student. The student's permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, ensuring a true and complete academic history. Compton Community College District will honor academic renewal actions by other regionally accredited institutions.

Procedures for implementing the policy will be developed in collegial consultation with the Academic Senate, as stated in Board Policy 2510.
