Compton Community College District Investigates Criminal Activity

On February 17, 2011, a Compton Community College District (CCCD) employee was arrested at the District for grand theft. The same employee has been placed on paid administrative leave pending a full investigation.

On March 2, 2011, a police report was taken about a second Compton District employee who admitted to committing a petty theft at the Compton Community College District. The details of the report were forwarded to the department head, who then placed the employee on paid administrative leave pending an investigation. A police report was filed, however the employee was not arrested.

These incidents are being fully investigated and legal action will be taken as warranted. The members of the communities we serve expect and demand that the District continue to provide the much-needed educational services, and we are committed to ensuring we provide reliable day-to-day operations.

Under the new leadership of the Compton Community College District Special Trustee, and the Chief Business Officer, we are working to restore public confidence in the District and to ensure the District's business operations are managed ethically and legally.

About the Compton Community College District

The Compton Community College District serves the communities of Carson, Compton, Enterprise, North Long Beach, Lynwood, Paramount and Willowbrook. The District is governed by a state-appointed Special Trustee, who works with the five-member elected Board of Trustees.
