Compton Community College District Redistricting Committee to Meet January 6, 2022

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) Redistricting Committee will hold its next two meetings on Thursday, January 6, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. and Thursday, January 20, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Both meetings are open to the public and take place via Zoom; meeting access information is available online: https://www.compton.edu/district/district_information/district-redistricting.aspx.

The Compton Community College District, along with many other public agencies and school districts in California, has begun a process to review and modify its elected trustee area boundaries. Every 10 years, local community colleges, city councils and other local agencies must adjust their elected trustee area boundaries to equalize the population. How and where district boundaries are drawn can shape communities' ability to elect the representatives of their choice.

Currently, trustees in the CCCD must live in the trustee area they represent. Residents vote by "trustee area," whereas, they may only vote for candidates who reside in their specific trustee area.

Governing Boards of community college districts are required, by the end of February 28, 2022, to adjust the boundaries of any or all trustee areas by using census population figures from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Census Bureau decennial census of the country's population conducted in 2020 and validated by the Population Research Unit of the California Department of Finance.

The CCCD Redistricting Committee held its first two meetings on November 30 and December 16, 2021. Agenda items included an overview of the CCCD Redistricting Action Plan, election of committee chair and vice chair, review of current CCCD Trustee Areas, and a review and discussion of the draft of two proposed maps for district boundary areas.
