To be considered for admission as a special part-time student, the student must meet the eligibility standards outlined in Education Code Section 52610.5, 48800 - 48802, and 76001 -76002 and 76300. Student and adult school administrators of the noncredit or adult education high school diploma program, must read and understand the following in:

- As part of the approval process, the principal or administrator must verify that the recommended student is pursuing a noncredit or adult education high school diploma or equivalency program and can benefit from college instruction. This approval must be completed each spring/fall semester and winter/summer intersessions.
- The district authorizes the admission of students who are enrolled in and continuously attending a noncredit or adult education high school diploma or high school equivalency program. This procedure provides students with special part-time status and allows them to enroll in up to 11 units at the college without paying standard enrollment fees.
- To be considered for admission as a special part-time student, the student must meet the eligibility standards outlined in Education Code Section 52610.5, 48800, and 76001.
- Adult dual enrollment students may elect to pay for other campus fees such as student representation fees and/or associated government ASG. Opt-out request on fees page.
- If an adult student graduates within the semester they intend to enroll into courses, the student is required to pay the enrollment and all other colleges fees.
- Students who withdraw from a course and/or have not made satisfactory progress in a course must receive approval from a Compton College counselor to be permitted to enroll in subsequent semesters or sessions.
- Section 76001(d) and Board Policy 5030 Fees.
- Students will be charged all other applicable fees in accordance with Board Policy 5030 Fees, unless an exemption applies.
- Application approval does not guarantee a seat in a class.
- Students are responsible for registering for their classes through the student portal.
- Students must clear up any prerequisites before registering for classes.
- Students may only enroll in the classes recommended and authorized by their adult school.
- Students will not receive priority registration status.
- Students are responsible for dropping all classes they no longer want to attend.
- Students that don't attend the first day of class may be dropped. Instructors may drop the student and give that seat to another student.
- Students must conduct themselves in a responsible and appropriate manner for a college environment. All students are subject to the student code of conduct. It is the responsibility of the student to read and understand the Student Code of Conduct and all relevant policies and procedures. (Compton College Board Policy 5138).
- Students are protected by the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Neither the parent, family member, nor a representative from the student's school may inquire about the student or obtain information on the student's academic performance, enrollment, or attendance without the expressed written consent of the student, regardless of the student's age.
- Students must meet all add and drop deadlines outlined in the schedule of classes in the online Schedule of Classes.
- Students must request college transcripts if their adult school requires transcripts to assign credit.
- The first two transcript requests are free. Student's grade(s) will become part of the permanent academic record.
