Accessing Services

Services available to all currently enrolled Compton College students with a verifiable disability.

Eligibility

The specific disability must be verified, and there must be an educational limitation that present a barrier to the learning process. Diagnoses may include, but not limited to:

- Acquired Brain Impairment
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Autism Spectrum
- Hearing
- Intellectual
- Learning
- Mental Health
- Other Health Condition
- Physical
- Visually Impaired

Documentation

Students must provide documentation to determine eligibility and request reasonable accommodations.

We accept Individual Education Plan (IEP/504) plans, Psycho-Educational Reports, letters from a licensed physician indicating diagnosis and functional limitations.

Services

Through the Special Resource program each eligible student will receive support services specific to their disability. Potential accommodations or academic adjustments may include:

Academic Accommodations:

- Testing Accommodation
- ASL Interpreting Services
- Note Taking Services
- Alternative Media
- Priority Registration
- Reduction of Units

Assistive Technology:

- Assistive Technology Training
- High Tech Center Lab Access
- Equipment Loans

Support Services:

- Academic, Career, and Personal Counseling
 - Disability Management Counseling
 - Liaison with Professors, On-Campus Departments, and Community Agencies
 - Specialized Tutoring
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Get started

The SRC Staff will begin an intake process, beginning with a face-to-face or virtual meeting. Next, following review of the student's disability documentation and functional limitations, reasonable accommodations will be discussed and approved.

All new students must complete this checklist:

- Apply to Compton College
 - Apply to FAFSA/CADAA (financial aid)
 - Complete the Online Orientation
 - Complete SRC Application
 - Review/sign SRC Student Rights and Responsibilities
 - Provide Documentation of Disability
 - Complete Intake of Services, Sign Release, and Student Educational Contract
 - Meet with SRC Counselor
 - Request Accommodations
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Confidentiality

Submitted documentation is used for the purpose of determining eligibility. Under FERPA, staff cannot discuss student information with parents and faculty without a student's permission.
